#### You Can Help Keep Michigan Kids Safe!

The Michigan Child Protection Law requires certain people to report their suspicions of child abuse or neglect to Children's Protective Services.

Learn more about your requirements to report suspected child abuse and/or neglect as a mandated reporter, by contacting your local MDHHS office for available training.

If you suspect abuse or neglect, report it any time day or night by calling 855-444-3911.

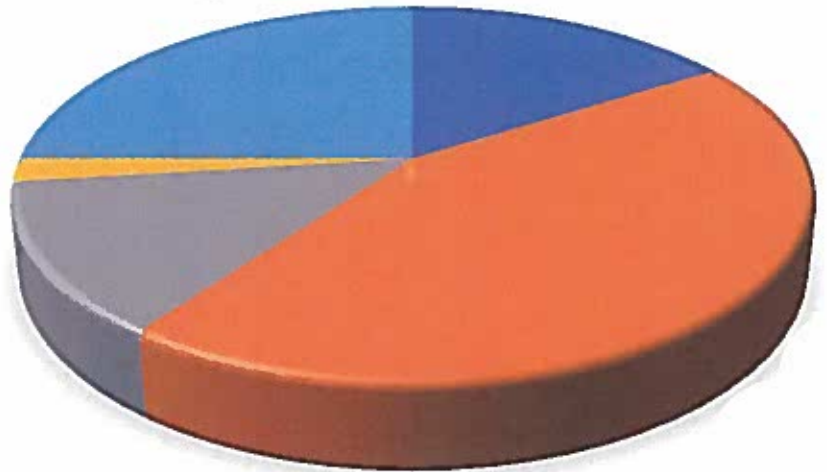

# MANDATORY REPORTING BY THE NUMBERS

To maintain current investigation timelines and staff ratios (with a high estimate of 40% increases based on other states experience and assuming the same percentage of reports require investigation), the State would need an additional 254 investigators and 56 intake staff, plus supervisors and some additional training costs. The approximate funding needed would be \$53M. This amount would be lower if fewer reports required investigation by percentage or if increases were lower.

## Types of Complaints (2017)



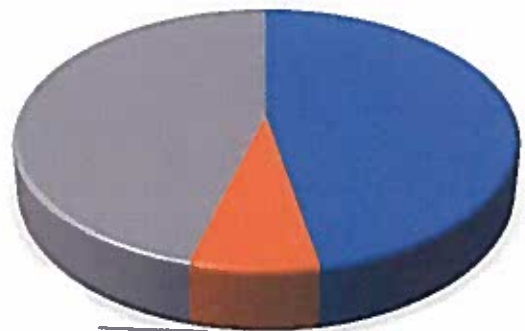
- Sexual Abuse
