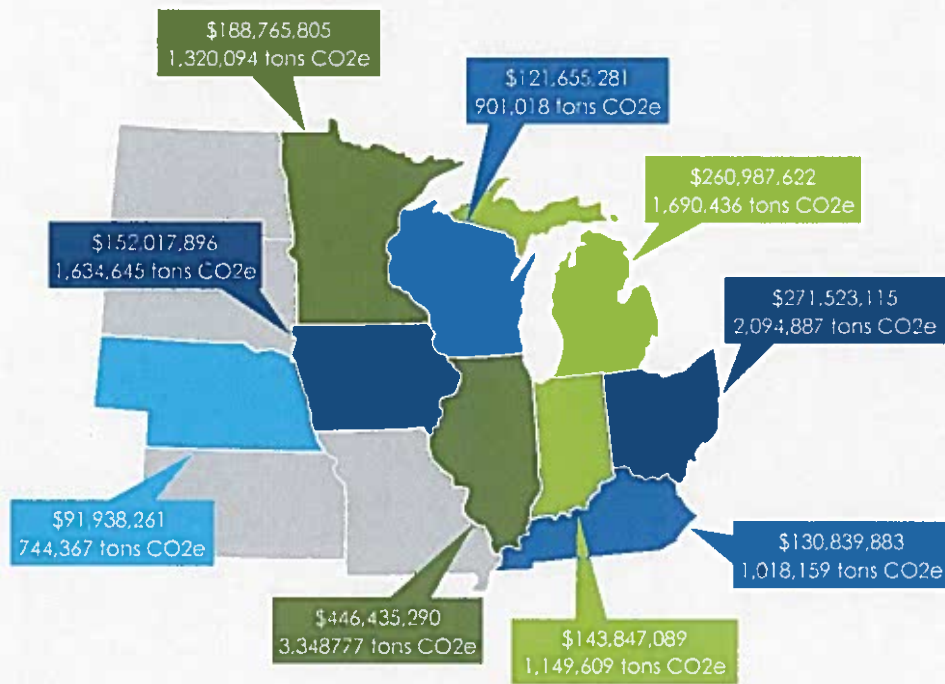


# Building Energy Code Impacts in the Midwest

Thanks to building energy codes, Midwest states saved:

Pay for **46,840** students to attend 4 years of college



Build **13,908** miles of new bike lanes



Buy **25,829** Tesla Model S electric cars



In CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent, that's like:



Powering **1,362,805** homes



Installing **3,194** new wind turbines



Removing **2,700,573** cars from the road
